Who we are

The Association for the Developmentally Disabled (ADD) has been serving the Franklin County area for more than 35 years. Formed by the Franklin County government, we have a long history of bridging the gaps and providing a service network for individuals with developmental disabilities. Specifically, we assist in placing individuals into small group living situations in the community. Within these communities, we can meet each person's special needs in an atmosphere that fosters independence in daily living, the community and on the job.

Who we serve

ADD community homes serve a wide range of adults in terms of age, functioning levels and kinds of disabilities. Individuals residing in ADD community homes are admitted through an intake process involving our team of qualified personnel. An applicant's eligibility is based on personal interviews, home visits, and evaluation of the individual's physical, social, emotional and cognitive functioning levels. This helps us to determine how we can serve them best and which ADD community home is most suited to his or her needs.

You have our commitment

Our home staff members are committed to providing consumers the support they need not only in their daily living situations but also through jobs they hold in both structured and competitive employment. Each consumer interacts with our well-trained and caring staff including direct care staff, residential managers, and quality assurance staff. Nurses and consulting therapists are available in certain qualifying community home settings. Each of these individuals works hard to create an environment conducive to the growth and development of each consumer.

You have choices

In any situation, you want to have a choice. Choosing a residence is no different. ADD community homes provide a number of living options including single-family homes, apartment units, and specially designed wheelchair-accessible facilities. We also offer help through our Supported Living Services.



You have our support

Supported Living Services are specific services provided to the consumer at their chosen community home. Through this program, a detailed plan is created and agreed upon by the consumer, county service and support administrator and ADD staff. The advantage to the plan is that it allows the individual to receive only the services they need. Those services can include personal care, homemaker needs and transportation. In addition, ADD staff work closely with the consumer to plan and achieve life and community living goals.
