Our purpose

The Association for the Developmentally Disabled (ADD) has been serving the Franklin County area for more than 35 years. Formed by the Franklin County government, we have a long history of bridging the gaps and providing a service network for individuals with developmental disabilities. Specifically, we provide care to individuals who are developmentally disabled, focusing on their personal opportunities for growth and participation in the community. As a leader in the field of developmental disabilities, ADD's mission is to provide quality and flexible services to support an individual's needs, desires and dreams.



Direct Care Staff – Direct Care staff support consumers who have developmental disabilities and live either in a group home setting or in their own home or apartment located in the central Ohio area. Responsibilities include assisting consumers in daily living activities like cooking, cleaning, passing medications, and transporting them to medical appointments and community activities.

Activity Therapist -The Activity Therapist provides a variety of well planned activities to meet the needs of the consumers involved that contribute to the achievement of the Individual Plan goals. Other responsibilities include developing, writing and implementing programs that reflect realistic goals for growth and development and monitoring the success of these programs.

Community Home Supervisor – In this position, the Supervisor oversees a specific group home or several locations where people with developmental disabilities live independently with support from ADD staff. Job duties include the scheduling of Direct Care staff, making appointments for consumers, money management, and daily living activities.
